High Honors: Students who earn a GPA of 4.0 or higher and receive no grades below an A- will be named to this highest honor.

Honors: Students who earn a GPA of 3.5-3.99 and receive no grades below a B will be named to this high rankings each semester.

Merit Roll: Students who earn a GPA of 3.0-3.49 and receive no grades below a B- will be named to this merit ranking each semester.

Semester Exams

Semester exams will be administered in all 7th -12th-grade classes at the end of each semester. Semester exams are comprehensive, covering material taught during the entire semester. Semester exam grades are included on report cards account for 10% of the final course grade 7th and 8th grade.

Semester exam grades are included on report cards account for 20% of the final course grade for all high school credit courses.

Seniors who will be graduating at the end of the year are exempt from taking 2nd-semester exams in classes in which they have maintained a B- or better during both 3rd and 4th quarters exam course.
