## MCA Ski Club Info for the 2021 Winter Season

We will be skiing/snowboarding at Boston Mills on Saturdays from 3:30-7:30, starting 1/9/21 for 5 consecutive weeks unless the club needs to cancel for weather, and then an additional week will be added at the end. Each student pass includes: 5 sessions of skiing or snowboarding with 4-hour lift ticket, rental equipment, and a group lesson for \$220. Ski club is for students age 8-18.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- Ski Club passes no longer include value passes or additional sessions beyond the included 5 sessions.

- Due to daily resort capacity limits, parents are NOT allowed to wait in the lodge. Parents will either need to drop off/pick up child or purchase a pass to ski/board with their child. With that said, child must be able to manage equipment/gear on their own.
